Situated in Chalmers St it's just a short 250 metre walk from the Gaelic Club, the festival's other main concert venue, creating a more compact and lively festival precinct.

All **SydFolkFest23** venues are within a short walk of each other making it easy to move between concerts, catch up with friends or just hang around taking in the atmosphere.

Tickets

A limited number of Early Bird Season Tickets are now on sale. A Season Ticket gives access to the entire programme with the ability to dip in and out of venues to experience the many artists and activities on offer over the festival weekend.
